

This study derives insights for the use of herbal medicine regarding the usage aims, role played by the type of illness, reasons for preferred usage and sources of information. The major use of **herbal medicines** is for health

promotion and therapy for chronic, as opposed to life-threatening, conditions. However, usage of traditional **remedies** increases when conventional **medicine** is ineffective in the **treatment** of disease, such as in advanced cancer and in the face of new infectious diseases.
