PLANT MORPHOLOGY



Botanical Name	: - <i>Andrographis paniculata</i> (Burm.f.) Wall ex Nees
Family	: - Acanthaceae
Local Name	: - Kalmegh, Bhuineem
Morphology	: -

Annual herb, branches quadrangular. Leaves simple, lanceolate or narrowly elliptic. Flowers are arranged in a secund raceme. The racemes are arranged in branched clusters near the stem tip known as terminal panicles. Flowers bi-lipped, tubular flowers, white with the lower lip having purple dots. The outer surface of the tube is covered in glandular hairs. Filaments hairy in the upper part. Capsules linear-oblong, acute at both ends, glabrous. Seeds many.

Flowering & Fruiting: - September to December

Uses : - Whole plant is used for the treatment for malaria and typhoid.
