PLANT MORPHOLOGY



Botanical Name : - *Buddleja asiatica* Lour.

Family : - Buddlejaceae

Local Name : - Buddleja

Morphology : -

Shrubs 2-4 m tall, branches densely hairy when young. Leaves opposite, oblanceolate, acuminate-caudate, attenuate at base, serrulate at base, serrulate, whitish pubescent beneath. Flowers in terminal or axillary speciform tomentose panicles. Calyx pubescent, 4 -lobed. Corolla white or pale violet. Stamens 4. Capsules ovoid to oblong about 3 mm across, yellow-brown.

Flowering & Fruiting: - February to June

Uses : -

The juice of the plant is applied as a wash to treat skin diseases.
