PLANT MORPHOLOGY



Botanical Name : - *Desmodium gangeticum* (L.) DC.

Family : - Fabaceae

Local Name : - Salperni

Morphology : -

Erect under-shrubs 1 m tall; branches angled, clothed with appressed white hairs. Leaves unifoliate, ovate-oblong, rounded, truncate or subcordate at base, acute to acuminate, glabrous and green above, paler and clothed with dense soft white hairs beneath; stipules scarious, linear-subulate. Flowers in few-flowered clusters along axillary and terminal racemes. Calyx hairy; teeth triangular, longer than the tube. Corolla pink or white. Pods 6–8-jointed, sparsely clothed with hooked hairs.

Flowering & Fruiting: September to December.

Uses : - Plant used control inflammation, fever and neurological imbalances.
