



#### Technical Session (Resource Persons Talks)


#### 1. Dr Veena Prakashe - "Development of Smart Libraries"


#### 3. Dr. H.G. Hosamani: "Role of Inflibnet in Development of Academic Libraries"






# > Participants of the e-Seminar




