This International E-Seminar was held on Monday, 9<sup>th</sup> August 2021 to commemorate the occasion of Padmashree Dr. Ranganathan's 129<sup>th</sup> birth anniversary, also celebrated as National Librarian's Day.

## \* Inaugural Session:

### > Introductory and Welcome Speech:

At the beginning of the Seminar, **Dr. Lalsingh Khalsa**, Principal of Mahatma Gandhi Arts,
Science, and Late N. P. Commerce College
welcomed all the dignitaries, conveners, event





organizers, and participants. He called libraries the lifeline of knowledge for school and college students and also research professionals, but he also insisted on the need for traditional physical libraries to evolve. He briefly touched upon the changing scenario of education in the country and the world.

Various online platforms like Khan Academy, NDLI, SWAYAM, etc. are emerging as alternative modes of dispensing knowledge. So libraries and library professionals have to change and adapt to this changing reality as progress and change go hand in hand. Sessions like this help in bridging the technological gap in education, he said.

Honorable Dr. Deepak Kumar Shrivastava, Mentor, INELI India and South Asia Divisional Librarian & Head of Govt. Divisional Public Library, Kota, Rajasthan, delivered the concept note. He focused on issues like lack of digitalization of libraries, lack of proper

understanding of the contributions of libraries and librarians, the need to make knowledge access via

libraries inclusive and equitable, the need to turn libraries into real education service centers, need for librarians to transform themselves from 'bookkeepers to teachers' librarians', etc. Dr. Ramanik Lengure from Renuka College, Besa, Nagpur, introduced the Concept Note speaker.


## > Participants of the e-Seminar
